



THE PRESIDENT'S ADDRESS

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Dear Members:

On July 21st and 22nd of this year, your organization convened the Second Confederate Alliance Conference that was held in Tennessee. It was heralded as 'The Gathering of the Gray'. Confederates from across the South attended with many driving hundreds of miles in order to attend. These men and women represented those organizations that presently comprise The Confederate Alliance. Other organizations outside of the Alliance were also in attendance. They also came from states across the South, not only for the purpose of meeting everyone, but to determine for themselves if our message of Unity & Solidarity was as 'true' as we have proclaimed it to be, and to understand the full meaning of our creed of: No More Evermore. Everyone was given the opportunity to speak and address the Conference, and all did participate.

Also attending the Conference were representatives from the Confederate Government - yes, our Confederate Government. The Alliance invited these men in order to explain and make clear that which many did not understand and, frankly, that which has been made unclear and deliberately confused by 'some' outside of the Alliance.

What many of you may be wondering is how can we have a Confederate Government when no elections have been held, followed with the many obvious questions that accompany that most basic question. Let me attempt to answer your question in three basic ways:

A) When the United States was first formed after the 1st American Revolution, we had 'framers' who represented each of the colonies. As such, they convened and, subsequently, wrote Articles of Confederation that was followed by the Constitution and the Bill of Rights. Those documents provided for the Foundation of Government that was to follow by way of elected officials to represent their constituents in each of the then Sovereign & Independent States.

B) Since our Confederate government and country was over-run and, subsequently, conquered by a Foreign Government by way of invasion, we have been a country, a land, and a people under foreign occupation and subjugation. What many DO NOT understand is that our Confederate Government was NEVER surrendered by any elected Confederate official! Many have been misguided and ill-educated to think that since our armies and military surrendered, this was tantamount to our government surrendering. IT IS NOT!

What we have lived under for the last 141 years is a de facto government - essentially a false government that rules over another because of conquest.

The de jour government (Confederacy) - that legal government that represented OUR country and OUR people prior to its Conquest - has been made dormant since its conquest and merely requires itself to be re-established by way of its representatives being returned to their rightful place prior to its overthrow.



C) The representatives of today's Confederate government, who were present in Tennessee in July, are, essentially, the same as those framers who created the foundation for the United States after the American Revolution. However, these representatives of our Confederate government already have a legal foundation from which to re-establish the Confederate government (de jour government), but merely require YOUR participation in which to do so. And it all begins with Confederate Citizenship that will lead to elected delegates and a subsequent Confederate Constitutional Convention to re-seat those vacant and dormant seats within the Confederate Government. Essentially, those are the A B C's of where we are today and how far we have come.

The Confederate Alliance Conference was an intensive two-day meeting in which much was discussed. This was NOT just another meeting in which the same old diatribe was spoken about. In other words, others telling us what we already know and pumping the crowd's emotions for their 'organizational' gains. This meeting discussed in deep detail the state of affairs within this country today. We explored in deep detail its departure from the Republic it once was into the Socialist Democracy it has become. We spoke in detail about the consequences visited upon the people of this country ever since 1865 and the complicit and illegal laws mandated and passed under the Central regime and the impact and effect they have had on everyone since. I am also equally pleased to announce the appointment of Commander Scott Fox as the Confederate Society of America's new Communications & Liaison Officer. Scott will presume these duties in addition to running his Illinois Division.

Last, but certainly NOT the least, we are very beholden to our Lord Almighty for seeing us through some very difficult times over these many years. I have often said that the odds for us Confederates to have gotten this far by 'Vegas' standards, were probably a billion to one. However, I have also said on many occasions that it has always been my belief, as well, that our Lord has been testing our 'metal' to determine whether or not we were deserving of another chance. Many times over the years, when I thought we were at our 'road's end', another door miraculously appeared and was opened to us, and, as such, allowed us to continue forward. The "Peaceful People" and Jihad

After 9/11, George Bush assured all of us that Islam is a religion of "peace," and that all they want is to be left alone to bother no one. Based on what I have seen since then, I'm somewhat inclined to disagree with that statement. Recent comments by the Pope brought a firestorm of demonstrations, protests, and calls for the Pope to grovel and apologize for what he supposedly said about Muslims. In reality, all he did was to quote from a Medieval text concerning the faith of Islam. George Friedman, writing for www.stratfor.com (<http://www.stratfor.com>) has made some interesting revelations regarding this. He noted that the Pope is "too savvy a politician" not to have known that his remarks would have caused such a reaction among Muslims. He could, after all, have chosen other quotes than this one from a Medieval text to make his point, but for some reason he chose to quote the text he did to get his point across when referring to Islam, and Friedman seems to feel that he did so intentionally.

Friedman has suggested that he did this to show public support for Christians in the Middle East, (who are routinely threatened by Muslim violence) and also to encourage Christians in Europe who are now beginning to look at the increasing Muslim presence in their own countries with more than a little alarm. Anyone remember what happened in France just a short while back?

Europeans, because of steadily declining birthrates, are steadily becoming overwhelmed by Muslim immigrants, and the potential violence of "jihad" (holy war) seems to be more of a possibility in many major cities in Western Europe. Pastor Steve Wilkins of Monroe, Louisiana has written that: "With the wave of recent Muslim-inspired attacks, the average European has little patience with the rhetoric about Islam being a 'religion of peace.' The Church must also begin to show that it recognizes the truth about Islam, or it will lose what credibility it has left among the minority of the faithful." So the Pope's comments can be considered somewhat of a warning, and to that extent I agree with them.

To clear up any misconceptions at this point, let me state that I am not Roman Catholic. I am a Presbyterian Calvinist, lest anyone think I am only defending the Pope because he is the spiritual head of my church. Such is not the case. Pastor Wilkins has noted that the West has not had to face a religiously motivated army since the 16th century. At that point they fought Islamic armies. He observed that the increasing secularism of both Western Europe and America, no doubt a legacy of the Enlightenment, has made us "singularly ill-equipped to face this threat realistically. Without question, our weakness has become evident to the radical Islamic leadership who are convinced that now is the time for a renewed crusade against Christianity."

And Pastor Wilkins has correctly observed that: " Our politicians haven't a clue about what to do aside from issuing naive statements appealing for justice and mercy to those who have no sympathy for a Christian view of justice and mercy." The Church should be in the forefront of this cultural conflict, not shooting Muslims, but rather preparing her people for the coming cultural upheaval and how to deal with it. She needs to repent of her decades of complacency and indifference to the world around her and pray that the Lord will move us to progress in continuing reformation and understanding, both in worship and obedience, and building a Christian culture that will withstand the assaults of infidels. We need, as Christians, to begin to wake up and smell the coffee!

I have a friend who has relatives in a Southeast Asian country, and he has spent some time there. At one point, he and a Muslim man became quite good friends. He once asked the Muslim about how they spread their faith, and because he was a friend, the Muslim was honest with him. The Muslim told him that when they (Muslims) were in a position of numerical inferiority, they sought to persuade people to join their faith, but whenever they got to the point where they assumed numerical superiority, at that point they sought the use of force, if persuasion would not work. "Convert or die" is still alive and well!

One member of what has been called an "Islamofascist" group made the statement that: "We tell the worshipper of the cross that you and the West will be defeated...We shall break the cross and spill the wine...[Allah] enable us to slit their throats, and make their money and descendants the bounty of the mujahideen." Sounds like a nice guy!

Some have stated, and correctly so, that Islam hates our guts because of our unconditional support for Israel and all that she does, no matter who gets hurt. I agree, that is one reason. Our national and theological fawning over the Zionist state in the Middle East has not exactly made us number one in the popularity polls, but there is more to it than just that., and the Church needs to begin to understand exactly what holy war means to Islam. I am a relative newcomer to this cause, as it has taken me a long time to wipe the wool from my eyes, so that I could see that there is no way to fix the Federal Beast. 2. Form peaceful protests and marches with public speeches. Invite the news. Create a stir. If Louis Farrakhan can have a "Million Man March," why not a Confederate March? We could stage it in the same Washington DC venue that Martin Luther King had his famous "I had a dream" speech. Think about it. Get every willing SVC group, every Commander, every member of the CSA government, every Confederate sympathizer. Attempt to get THOUSANDS on the street. 4. If anyone has access to the media, we use it as a forum to promote the message. Not too many know about us, and the few that have heard of us have a totally misrepresentative idea of what we are all about.
5. We can pool our resources and put out an ad on the largest outlet we can collectively afford. A TV ad is too expensive for 1 person, or even a dozen people, but how about a fundraiser to get the money needed?

Is this too aggressive? Is it going too far? Is it far enough? Have these things already been tried? Please give me your thoughts. We need an aggressive plan of action, as our window of opportunity is closing!

It is true that public opinion does not make our cause any more (or any less) legitimate. However, public opinion can go a long way toward helping our cause and will make the Federal Beast stand up and take notice that we are serious.

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VATICAN LETTERS TO PRESIDENT DAVIS

The Cardinal gave the following information from the state archives of the Vatican. There was a letter by President Davis to Pope Pius 9th dated September 25, 1863, following a letter by the pope to the archbishop of New Orleans and New York City, directing those prelates to address their dioceses on the enlistment of catholic (Irish and German) in the federal army. The pope did not address the causes of the conflict, nor referred to the atrocities committed by the Federals during the Romney campaign of 1861, the SHENANDOAH retreat of 1862, and Gen. Pope in northern Virginia, but he stressed the Christian conscience and brotherhood in Christ as reason to refuse service in the yankee army. Here is the letter dated 25 sept.1863 by Pres, Davis to the Pope. From *A Memoir of Jefferson Davis* in two volumes, completed by his wife Varina Davis after his death.

VERY VENERABLE SOVEREIGN PONTIFF:

"The letters which you have written to the clergy of New Orleans and New York have been communicated to me, and I have read with emotion the deep grief therein expressed for the ruin and devastation caused by the war which is now being waged by the United States against the States and people which have selected me as their President, and your orders to your clergy to exhort the people to peace and charity. I am deeply sensible of the Christian charity which has impelled you to this reiterated appeal to the clergy. It is for this reason that I feel it my duty to express personally, and in the name of the Confederate States, our gratitude for such sentiments of Christian good feeling and love, and to assure Your Holiness that the people, threatened even on their own hearths with the most cruel oppression and terrible carnage, is desirous now, as it has always been, to see the end of this impious war; that we have ever addressed prayers to Heaven for that issue which Your Holiness now desires; that we desire none of our enemy's possessions, but that we fight merely to resist the devastation of our country and the shedding of our best blood, and to force them to let us live in peace under the protection of our own institutions, and under our laws, which not only insure to every one the enjoyment of his temporal rights, but also the free exercise of his religion. I pray Your Holiness to accept, on the part of myself and the people of the Confederate States, our sincere thanks for your efforts in favor of peace. May the Lord preserve the days of Your Holiness, and keep you under His divine protection.

(Signed) JEFFERSON DAVIS

The Pope's reply:

"ILLUSTRIOUS AND HONORABLE PRESIDENT:

We have just received with all suitable welcome the persons sent by you to place in our hands your letter, dated 23d of September last. Not slight was the pleasure we experienced when we learned, from those persons and the letter, with what feelings of joy and gratitude you were animated, illustrious and honorable President, as soon as



you were informed of our letters to our venerable brother John, Archbishop of New York, and John, Archbishop of New Orleans, dated the 18th of October of last year, and in which we have with all our strength excited and exhorted those venerable brothers that, in their Episcopal piety and solicitude, they should endeavor, with the most ardent zeal, and in our name, to bring about the end of the fatal civil war which has broken out in those countries, in order that the American people may obtain peace and concord, and dwell charitably together. It is particularly agreeable to us to see that you, illustrious and honorable President, and your people, are animated with the same desires of peace and tranquility which we have in our letters inculcated upon our venerable brothers. May it please God at the same time to make the other peoples of America and their rulers, reflecting seriously how terrible is civil war, and what calamities it engenders, listen to the inspirations of a calmer spirit, and adopt resolutely the part of peace. As for us, we shall not cease to offer up the most fervent prayers to God Almighty, that He may pour out upon all the people of America the spirit of peace and charity, and that He will stop the great evils which afflict them. We, at the same time, beseech the God of pity to shed abroad upon you the light of His grace, and attach you to us by a perfect friendship.
 " Given at Rome, at St. Peter's, the 3d of December, 1863, of our Pontificate 18.

President Craig, it is not a formal recognition, but a note by a federal agent runs thus: It is obvious that the kindness shown to Jefferson Davis as a child during his education years at St. Thomas College Catholic School in Kentucky influenced his life. The letter of the Pope is the facto recognition of the Confederate States, and J. Davis as President, the recognition of peace on his terms by separation of the nations. His friendliness to the Catholic church was well repaid by that institution which always, under such circumstances, rewards its tools. The Pope at the moment of President Davis' arrest to be tried for treason, it was the distinguished catholic attorney Charles O'Connor of N.Y. City who offered his services, which were accepted in President Davis' Defense. During President Davis' imprisonment, the pope sent him a picture of himself autographed, with the dedication, "Come unto me all ye who are weary and heavy laden, and I will give you rest."

The formation of the First Continental Congress was accomplished by a Constitutional Convention of delegates from the States (Colonies) as was the Second Continental Congress in 1776. By no means did the majority of the population support the effort, but then, most did not openly oppose it either until the British began attacking and then around 100,000 Tories fled to Canada to remain subjects of the King of England as they preferred a monarchy. It was a Similar Constitutional Convention that established the Confederate States of America in Montgomery, Alabama in 1861.

A series of six Constitutional Conventions were held starting with the Asheville Declaration in 1999. A Constitutional Court was formed at the Jackson, Mississippi 2001 convention by the State Chairmen. The State Chairmen elected from among themselves those to serve also as Justices of the Constitutional Court to be in number 3 - 9 Justices. They are normally to serve until they are no longer State Chairmen or Registrars.

The Constitutional Court decided that, due to the acceleration by the New World Order under the Clinton and now the Bush Administration, and the destruction of any remaining semblances of the nation of our forefathers of 1776 - 1860, we could wait no longer, and the Justices decided to initiate the Restoration of the Confederate States of America for the preservation of our people. Thus, on November 1, 2004, the Court decided to initiate the Restoration by recruiting a living C.S.A. Registered Citizenry and ordered a Voter's Registration Drive to begin.

Interim National C.S.A. Government

The Constitutional Court issued orders to organize several interim court committees to serve until sufficient re-staffing of dormant governmental offices had occurred by virtue of Constitutional Conventions within each Confederate State to allow the seating of a national Senate and the election of a national President for the Confederacy. Thus, the Court ordered the creation of:

- 1) A **Registrars Committee** to be headed by a National Registrar and to include State and County Registrars serving essentially similar to county clerks in this restrictive Voter's Registration Drive.
- 2) A **Confederate Intelligence Bureau (CIB)** to be headed by a Director. The CIB was envisioned to operate considering various scenarios of things that might occur, so appropriate responses could be considered



ahead of time, and also to run background checks on certain individuals who might be suspected of false motives in working supposedly with the C.S.A. or in working against the government. A Surgeon General was attached to the CIB to consider nuclear and biological threats that might develop and provide instructions for alternative treatments in such cases.

3) A **C.S.A. Council** was ordered to serve being made up initially of the various State Registrars. This council is to serve as sort of an interim legislative body in approving new expenditures and to participate in and vote on C.S.A. positions on various serious matters so as to reflect the feelings of the Citizens of the several States. Once a State holds its own Constitutional Convention and elects officers to re-staff the dormant governmental positions such as Governor, the State Registrar appointed is relieved of his duty, and that State Governor has the duty of appointing his own State Registrar, and secondly, that State Governor now sits and votes on the C.S.A. Council in the place of the appointed State Registrar. As more and more States complete their own elections in this manner, the council becomes the **C.S.A. Governor's Council** and no longer operates as a Court Committee, but rather on its own behalf. The C.S.A. Council reviewed and updated the Plan of Liberation, much of which is revealed above and includes the natural transformation from an interim government to the actual national Government of the Confederate States of America based upon the updated 1861 C.S.A. Constitution.

4) The Constitutional Court also ordered the re-establishment and re-staffing of the **Treasury** in accordance with the authority of Act 25 of the C.S.A. Congress passed February 21, 1861. The Constitutional Court, in conjunction with and concurrence of the national C.S.A. Council, decided that it was not reasonable nor wise to re-staff the military of the Confederacy, nor to authorize militias by the Government at this time. The C.S.A. has no authority to restrict private individuals from becoming involved in private militias, that being strictly beyond the scope of authority of the government.

The Confederate Caucus Political Phase

Once the basic national government is re-staffed with a Senate and a President, the recruiting should increase and continue producing the Confederate Caucus which heralds in the political phase where Confederate-minded candidates can be elected by existing Democrat, Republican, or Libertarian parties, as well as Independents or various Southern Parties in the States. These elections will be for the existing satellite States where the tax base and power resides.

The Merger Phase

As Confederate politicians gain control of the various State Satellite States, they may pass Bills of Merger wherein they vote to merge the satellite State government and assets into the resurrected Confederate State Government. In a sense, a bill of merger accomplishes a secession by the Satellite State and provides that such State merge into the existing and resurrected Confederate State. This is a bit different than the secession movement of 1861 and even more justified. It is not a hostile action but a genuine right of the people under the Declaration of Independence, as well as a political right.

The Plea for a Peace Treaty

Once several States have been absorbed into their legitimate Confederate State Governments, and such Confederate State Government are by then already serving as States of the National Confederate States of America, they can press the Federal Union for a Peace Treaty, with termination of occupation of course. Depending upon the circumstances of the time and timing of the event, that may or may not be received by the United States (Federal Union).

Bills of Liberation

Should the United States reject or ignore the plea for Peace Treaty negotiations put forth by the Confederate States of America, those Confederate States will then be forced by Federal Union's refusal to negotiate a Peace Treaty to pass Bills of Liberation containing mandatory and enforced termination of occupation. The situation would be far different than in 1861, since the populations of the Confederacy are now nearly equal to that of the Northern States, and the Northern States have developed heavy empathy for the South, and there is no African Slavery issue. In the 1861 situation, perhaps 90% of the manufacturing was done in the North, while cotton, citrus, vegetables, and tobacco were raised in the South. Today, 85% of the petrochemical and oil industries are along the Gulf Coast. The Federal Union has gained ill fame throughout the world, whereas most of the world has developed empathy for the South. It is most likely that, under these conditions, a stalemate would result and negotiations would ensue for the benefit of both nations and the world.

Negotiation Phase

Indeed negotiations would be mandatory and extensive. Arrangements must be made for exchange of Embassies with the United States and other countries. Old treaties would have to be reviewed. Perhaps the United States would like to saddle the Confederacy with "our share" of the national debt our captors have foolishly run up well past bankruptcy. Yet, the war damage and plundering and confiscation of Southern



plantations and estates and other assets and forests, etc. must also be accounted for. Then, there is the military equipment and military and other federal assets in the South which we will keep, since our income taxes unlawfully taken from us by fraud and theft have easily paid for this equipment. Also, the Confederate States of America did not borrow vast sums of money from the Bank of England to support the Lincoln War of Aggression for which the income tax was covertly designed to repay along with the plundered Southern estates and assets. The Confederacy borrowed money from France and repaid these loans with bails of cotton at excessively low prices. Thus the Confederate States of America has no debt to the Bank of England, and, having paid back the French loans, owes France nothing more than perhaps a little gratitude.

There will need to be agreements on navigation of certain Southern waterways such as the Mississippi to the Great Lakes. There should be agreements on air quality, pollution, arrangement concerning the electrical grid, coastal waters, air traffic, radio and TV transmissions, etc. Banking agreements would be crucial, and, of course, the rights of Northern stockholders to receive their dividends from the vast industrial/petrochemical complex investments in the South. There shall be no theft of assets (no nationalization of industries) by the Confederacy, and Southern investors should expect the same allowance for their dividends on investments they may own in Northern industries.

Clearly, the U. S. Commerce Department, and the IRS, and the SEC will have no jurisdiction in the Confederacy. (Actually they have none now, except perhaps over their satellite States wrongly, illegally, and involuntarily forced upon the Southern States resulting in a puppet empire.)

Also, of course, is the demand for the immediate (within two weeks or less) removal of Federal Courts and their alphabet soup entourage of Marshals, U.S. Attorneys, FBI, CIA, NAS, DEA, FDA, BATF, EPA, SEC, INS, FCC, Homeland Security, FEMA, U.S. Department of Customs, Department of Education, DOA, HUD, DIA, DOE, Federal Railroad Administration, USPS, Secret Service, SSA Department of Labor, DOT, and the Department of Health and Welfare. No doubt, there are dozens of other agencies that must also be removed. (The houses and assets of the federal personnel being deported shall not be confiscated, but shall remain the property of the persons being deported.) Other international organizations such as the IRS and United Nations would be closed down and deported from the Confederacy immediately.

Special envoys from the United States will serve in each of the agencies being removed to assist both the personnel being removed and the Confederate transition team for those agencies deemed important for continuance in the Confederacy or the States. Trade envoys from the United States, Canada, and Mexico, in particular, would be welcome. In reality, the emergence of the Confederate States of America as a liberated nation will greatly enhance the economy of the United States and perhaps save it from economic collapse. The World bankers will recognize that benefit even though it does not include the formation of the Union of North America as a new nation.

Longer termed phase out schedules would seem reasonable for the U.S. Forestry, Army Corp. of Engineers, Coast Guard, Fanny May, FHA, Department of Veteran's Affairs, Bureau of Prisons, U.S. Army, U.S. Navy, U.S. Air Force, and NASA. (NASA could be continued in each State they are now in by incorporating in those States). Military personnel born in or desiring to remain in the Confederacy shall be given an opportunity for amnesty from deportation. Other federal personnel being deported may, after a reasonable time abroad, apply for immigration into the Confederate States, should they desire.

Other negotiations would be necessary with Mexico and China, in particular, over ports, customs offices, transportation, and the security of our borders. Agreements with Mexico would be important in regards to the recognized borders between the two countries. Trade arrangements would be crucial, as well.

**The Prospect of Another Military Invasion
of the Confederate States of America by the United States?**

If the negotiation phase is accomplished with fairness and wisdom, the Yankee public demand for a new invasion and re-conquest of the Confederacy will be diminished. Also, we will have substantial world support for our liberation from the hated United States. A U.S. Invasion of the liberated Confederate States of America is not likely and would fail, if tried, as did the recent Israeli invasion of Lebanon.

Should there be at least 8 or 10 States (perhaps becoming as many as 21 States) that will have merged their satellite state governments into their respective Confederate State governments and who will have recalled and taken control of their own National Guard divisions from the Federal Union complete with equipment, etc., the Federal Union will be faced with a formidable world class military force of which they would not be capable of defeating from the offset. The U.S. Military is already overcommitted, and their funds are simply unavailable for a major war, or even for the invasion of Iran, much less of the Confederacy. A classic Ukrainian standoff would exist, and since it could be economically advantageous to the United States to allow the Confederacy to remain and simply negotiate reasonable settlements and arrangements for future cooperation and commerce, and considering the lack of cultural hatred between the two nations, peace would be inevitable and a proper Peace Treaty would result.

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
